Preface

The following information is based on the extraordinary effort of Mrs. Grace S. Luebke dated 23 June 1974. Mrs. Luebke visited the cemetery in 1974, interpreted and transcribed the information she was able to discern on the weathered headstones in the cemetery. Her handwritten notes were typed by Thaddeus B. Hurd four days later and are provided in APPENDIX A of this document as the "Original 1974 Hineline Cemetery Records."

The 1974 Records include the names of 56 Sandusky Co., Ohio residents who were laid to rest in the Hineline cemetery between the years of 1842 and 1877. 20 were children one year or less in age.

In this document, the information transcribed by Mrs. Luebke is compared to several family history records, specifically the Gahn, Hetrick & Kreilick families. As result, it was possible to verify or correct the information in 17 of the records that Mrs. Luebke first documented in 1974. The few corrections are noted. Additional information is included where available to assist other researchers.

The Kreilick family history of John Adam Kreilick indicates he was one of the early pioneers of Sandusky County – arriving in 1835. John Adam Kreilick is known to have lived 70 years 6 month according to the Kreilick family history, “John Adam Kreilick ...died in 1842 aged 70 years and 6 months. His grave is in the old Mud Creek Cemetery in Rice Township.” At that point in time, this definitely refers to the cemetery located on the Able M. Hineline farm located just west of County Road 128 about 1/4 mile south of Mud Creek. It has now become known as the “Hineline Cemetery.” There is no other record or headstone in the cemetery for an Adam Kreilick. John Adam Kreilick had a son Adam who was born in 1804 and died in 1891. A recent (10-4-2003) picture of the weathered headstone clearly shows how the date could be interpreted as 1872 but the “7” is actually a weathered “4” by comparing it to the “7”s in the line below “70 yrs. 6 mo. 17 d.” The Hineline Cemetery was used through 1877 (see record for Almada Hindin (d. Dec 1, 1877)). After 1877, the St. Paul Lutheran Church congregation used the “Hetrick Cemetery” located on the east side of County Road 128, on the Peter Hetrick farm, surrounding the St. Paul Lutheran Church (also referred to as the Mud Creek Church.). The “Hetrick Cemetery” later became known as the St Paul Lutheran Cemetery.

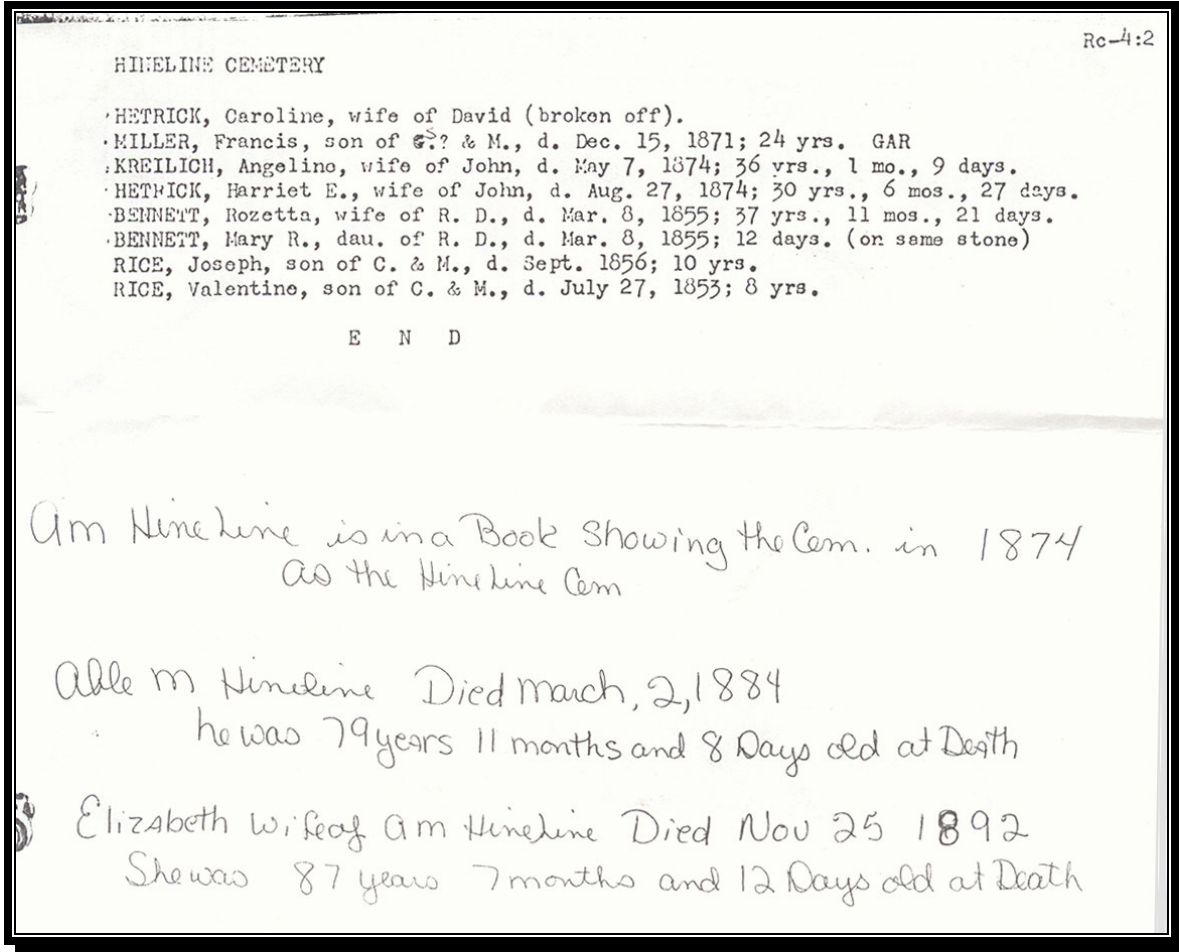

APPENDIX B

It is not known why the community stopped using the Mud Creek or Hineline Cemetery. It may have been associated with the construction of the significant drainage ditch between CR 128 and the Hineline farm that made access to the cemetery very difficult. In any case, around the mid 1870's the community started using the cemetery on the east side of the road, referred to as the "Hetrick Cemetery" and later became known as the St. Paul's Lutheran Church Cemetery, now the Faith Lutheran Cemetery.

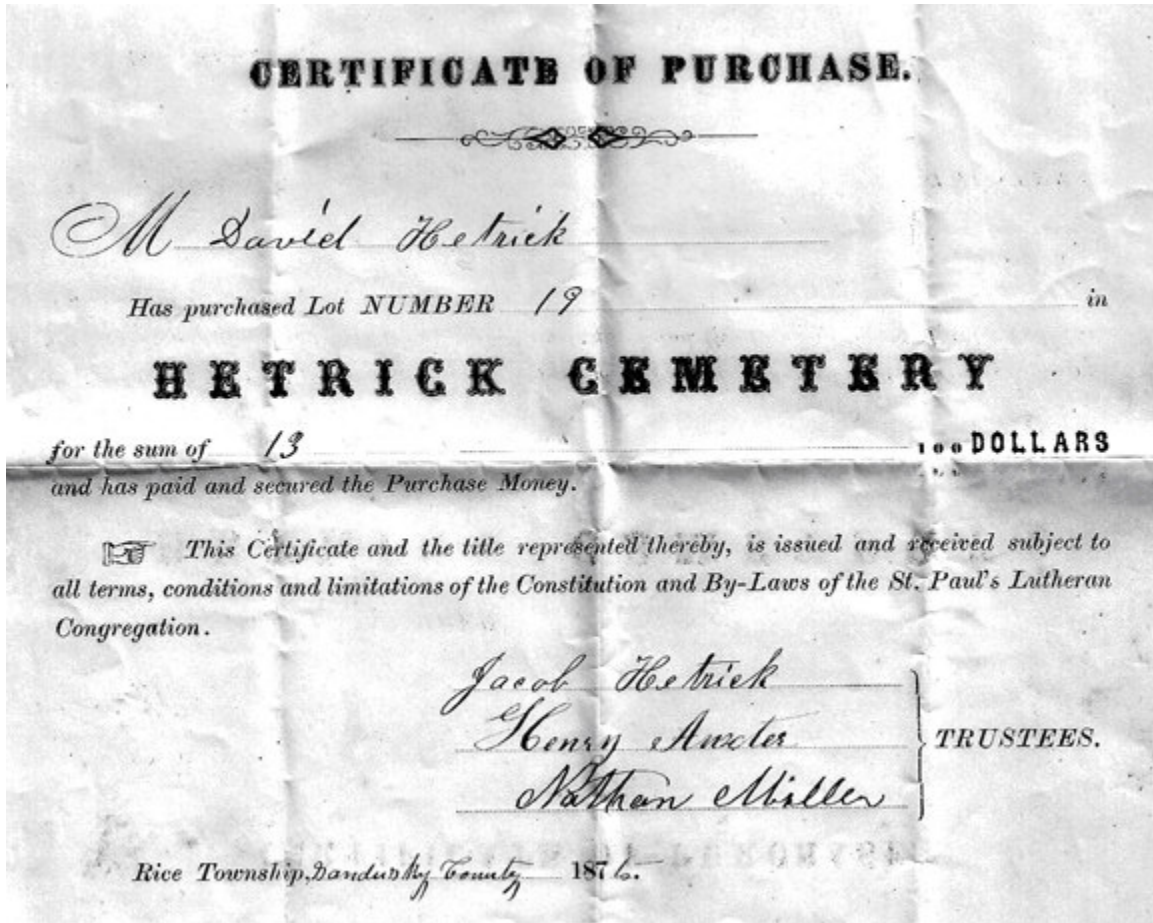


Figure 1 Peter Hetrick Purchased Lot 19 in the Hetrick Cemetery, 1875

David Hetrick Purchased Lot 19 in the Hetrick Cemetery in 1875. David's older brother Jacob was one of the three Trustees of St. Paul's at the time of this purchase. Henry Auxter, another Trustee, was his brother in law (husband of Harriet Hetrick).

Research continues to determine why the community started a second cemetery.
